

DPM2000 : RIP Configure Device Plug-in : TN #9

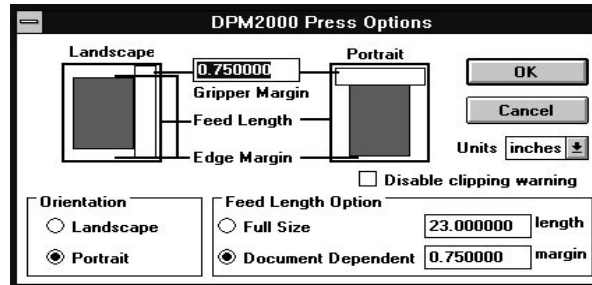
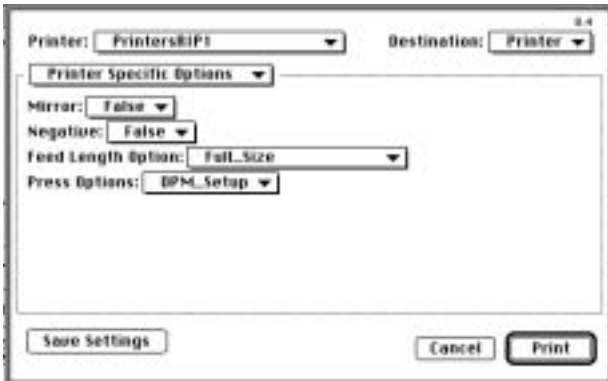
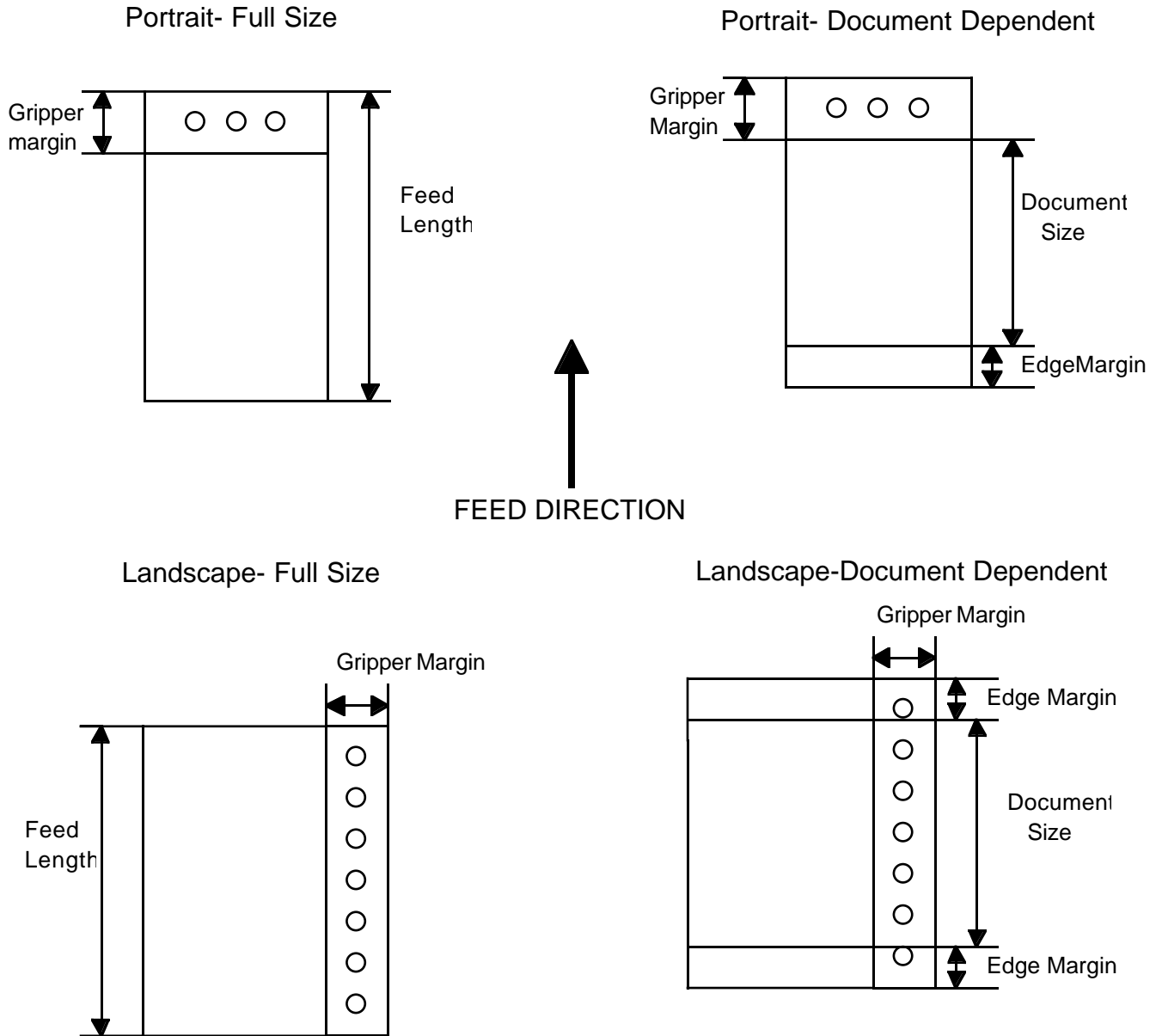


Figure 1 The DPM2000 Press Options dialog

- In the Orientation box, select either Landscape or Portrait. Note that they are used here as press types; they do not change the orientation of the document as printed on the plate.
- Select Units to be inches, millimeters, picas or points. This affects the Gripper Margin, Feed Length and Edge Margin.
- Feed Length Option box:
 - Change the value for the (feed) length to change the height of a portrait plate, as hung on the press, and the width of a landscape plate. The minimum value is 12 inches.
 - Click the Full Size radio button to set the size of the plate the same as the feed length. The edge margin is not used.
 - The Document Dependent option is provided to set the feed length based on the document size in the feed direction. Click the radio button and specify the additional edge margin. The minimum value is 0.75 inches. The feed length is computed by the following system:

Portrait Press: Plate Length=Gripper Margin+Document Size+Edge Margin

Landscape Press: Plate Length=Document Size+(2 x Edge Margin)
(Refer to Figure 2 for a better illustration of these parameters.)
- Select or deselect the “Disable Clipping Warning”. (If the “Disable Clipping Warning” box is checked and the image doesn’t fit on the specified plate size, the DPM2000 will clip the image it receives, even if it doesn’t fit correctly. If the box is not checked, the DPM2000 will display a warning dialog.)
- Select OK or Cancel to close the DPM2000 Press Options dialog and return to the Page Setup dialog.



When printing from your application you can choose whether you want to use the document Dependent Length or the Full Size Length. This is done through the Printer Specific Options box.

This choice will over ride what was chosen as the default in the Page Setup at the RIP.
